



Multilateral Pre-Inspection Form

Submit this completed form to EBMUD to request an inspection for parcels with more than one lateral OR a lateral which serves more than one parcel. Scheduling an appointment using the www.eastbaypsl.com website or failure to provide a complete map prior to scheduling will subject the property owners to **enforcement action such as appointment cancellation.**

- Complete this form. Submit with map to psl@ebmud.com at least 2 weeks prior to desired appointment date to allow 2 weeks for EBMUD staff review.
- This pre-inspection form is valid for 1 year after approval. After 1 year, a new pre-inspection form and map must be submitted.
- **NO INSPECTION WILL BE SCHEDULED UNLESS THIS FORM AND MAP ARE REVIEWED BY STAFF.** Only after you receive written approval from EBMUD staff, call (510) 287-1599 to schedule an inspection.
- A revised map must be submitted if field observations identify discrepancies in this project's previously approved map. Additional inspections will not be scheduled until the revised map is approved.

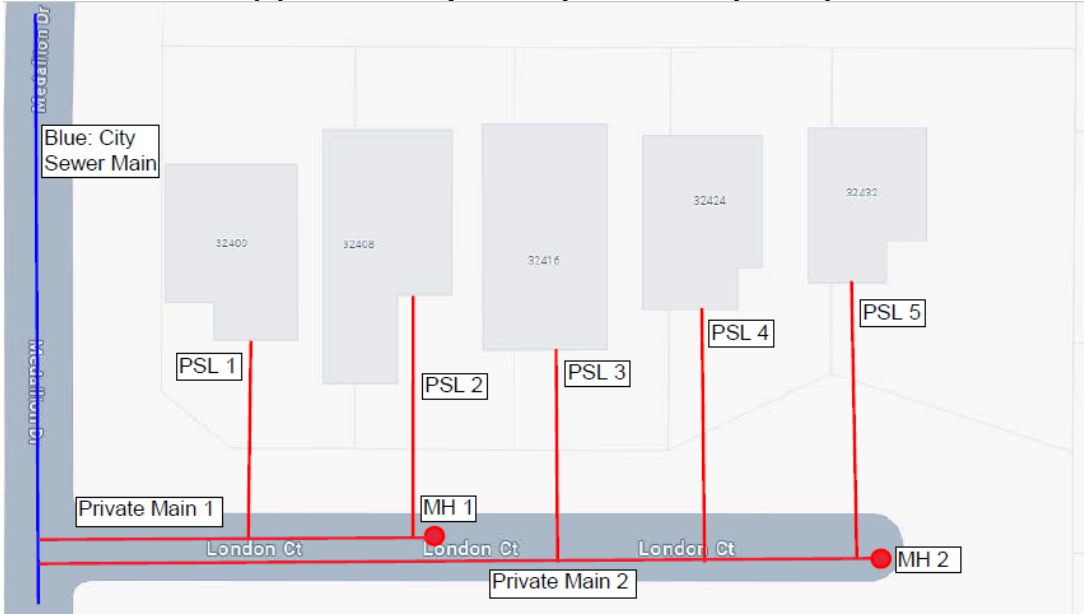
Map Requirements with Examples

- As required in the Contractor Guidelines, for parcels with more than one lateral OR a lateral which serves more than one parcel, the contractor must include a map with this pre-inspection form showing the parcel/community boundary, all laterals, private mains, and private manholes of the parcel or parcel group to EBMUD prior to scheduling. Label all laterals, private mains, private manholes, city mains to which the property connects, and bordering city streets. Mark any laterals that do not convey flow (e.g., lines that have been/will be abandoned).
